

Peconic Estuary Program Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan (CCMP) Tracking System

The Peconic Estuary Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan (CCMP) Tracking System was developed in Microsoft Access 2000. The database lists the implementation status of all 340 actions in the CCMP as of March 2004, including the 79 priority actions. All actions are classified as ongoing or finite, based on the projected duration of the project. For ongoing actions, implementation status is categorized as fully implemented, partially implemented, or not initiated. For finite actions, implementation status is categorized as complete, substantial (51-99% complete), limited (1-50% complete), or not initiated.

Upon opening the database, the green “Home” page will appear. To navigate through the database, click one of the buttons on the opening screen to view the actions, which are organized by chapter. The navigation arrows at the bottom of the page allow movement among actions. To view the implementation status, simply click on the “Details” button beneath each action item. A blue pop-up window will open to display information about the specific action. The database shows the 2004 status as well as the status reported during the 2001 implementation review. Initiation and completion dates are depicted where available. Close the pop-up window to view other actions (by clicking the “x” in the top right-hand corner of the blue box). To view actions from a specific chapter, click “Home” on the top toolbar to return to the green start-up page. Once on the “Home” page, click the button next to the desired chapter.

To view the status of priority actions, click the “Priority Only” button in the blue pop-up box (which can be reached by clicking “Details” in the top toolbar). Use the navigation arrows at the bottom of the blue pop-up window to move among the 79 priority actions.

To exit the database, you must first close any of the blue pop-up windows, if applicable, and then click “Home” on the top toolbar to return to the green start-up page. Click the “Exit” button.

Regular updates to the database will provide information on implementation progress.
