
## Critter Crossword

## <u>Across</u>

- **4.** This fish uses the Peconic River to move from saltwater to freshwater in the spring. (alewife)
- **5.** These shellfish have hundreds of beautiful blue eyes on the edge of their shell. (**scallops**)
- **6.** This crab is known for having one large claw. (**fiddler**)
- **8.** Birds and other marine life feed on the eggs of this ancient critter. (**horseshoe crab**)
- **9.** This fish is flat, lives on the bottom of the sea floor and has both eyes on one side of it 's face. (**flounder**)
- **11.** This marine mammal can be seen lounging on rocks in Montauk most often during winter. (**seal**)

## Down

- 1. You may see an area on the beach blocked off to protect this bird's nests. (piping plover)
- 2. This crab has a soft body and will use snail shells to protect itself. (hermit)
- **3.** This 'fish' isn't actually a fish at all and if you touch it you might get stung. (**iellyfish**)
- **5.** This soft-bodied animal has tentacles but is smaller than an octopus. (**squid**)
- **7.** This shellfish will use it's 'foot' to bury under the sand. (**clam**)
- **10.** You might find this bird perched high up in nests on specially made platforms. (**osprey**)
