NEP Reauthorization and Increased Funding

NEPs Reauthorized until 2026 - Protect and Restore America's Estuaries Act.

Current Federal Funding: \$662,500 to \$700,000 (\$37,500)

- NYS Environmental Protection Fund
 - \$200K to \$450,000 (\$250K)
- Southampton CPF
 - \$206,850 (passed by resolution)
- East Hampton Town
 - \$99,050 (Town Board Agreement, moves to resolution and public hearing)
- Town of Southold
 - \$24,500 (Town Board Agreement, moves to resolution and public hearing)
